

AISV was founded in 1993 and its first graduating class was in 2011. AISV is accredited by NEASC (MSA) and the Council of International Schools (CIS). AISV is associated with the United States Embassy and also a member of the U.S. Department of State and the Office of Overseas Schools. The IB Diploma Programme was implemented in 2013 and the first IB Diplomas were awarded in 2015. It is the only authorized IB DP (International Baccalaureate Diploma Program) school in Lithuania that is also fully accredited in the U.S.

This year we have 323 students from 33 different nationalities enrolled from Pre-K through 12th grade with 95 high school students. Approximately, 44 % of students are Lithuanians, 18% are American citizens, and 38% are from other countries. AISV is proud to that 8 % of school budget goes for the tuition reduction program in middle and high school.

We boast an outstanding staff that consists of the best local talent and highly recruited overseas staff. Over 75% of the faculty holds advanced degrees and the average student/teacher ratio is 5 to 1.

The language of instruction is English and all students take either a native or non-native Lithuanian class along with a second language. Following AISV's mission and vision, all students in high school are required to support the school and local community by planning and participating in community service activities. Students have participated in environmental sustainability projects, supported refugees and local orphanages, and planned fundraising activities to support local organizations.

The school is part of CEESA (Central and Eastern European School Association) and students have the opportunity to participate and compete in many extra-curricular activities to promote sportsmanship, leadership, the arts, and international mindedness. They can join activities such as Student Council, Model UN, National Honor Society, Speech and Debate, Film Festival, Math club, Drama, Tallinn Olympics (a friendly Olympics for the Baltic region), and sports such as swimming, volleyball, soccer, badminton, and basketball.

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT STATEMENT

Due to Covid-19 and countries' guidelines, students went into quarantine on March 13th, 2020. The class of 2022 completed their grade 10 year virtually. Due to governmental regulations, from October until May 2021, high school students were studying online, learning synchronously and asynchronously, depending on the courses. For this new year, students are back in school but have had to move sporadically to online learning as dictated by our school's Covid guidelines and governmental regulations. Furthermore, in order to adhere to health and safety recommendations and guidelines, students have had limited access to extracurricular activities. AISV has maintained its grading policy throughout its period.
