



Dear Parents,

Below is the list of supplies your child(ren) will need to bring on the first day of school in August. These are items that the school does not provide. Please note that these items may need to be replaced/refilled and turned in to the classroom teacher after the Winter break. Additionally, all supplies and clothing should be clearly marked with the student's name.

PRE-KINDERGARTEN

- 2 packages of baby wipes
- A standard-sized backpack
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 reusable water bottle with student's name
- Indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school)
- Non-marking gym shoes (velcro preferred) & sports clothes for Physical Education
- An oversized shirt for Art classes
- A complete change of clothes to be left at school (shirt, pants, socks, and underwear)
- A pack of diapers for toddlers if necessary

KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 2

- A standard-sized backpack
- 5 boxes of tissues
- 1 reusable water bottle with student's name
- Indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school)
- Complete change of clothes to be left at school (shirt, pants, socks, and underwear)
- Non-marking gym shoes (velcro preferred) & sports clothes for Physical Education

GRADE 1 & 2

PE: 1 pair of non-marking gym shoes (labeled with child's name). Drawstring (or similar) bag for carrying PE uniform (each student will need to purchase 1 PE kit at the beginning of the school year, distributed in PE class).

Visual Arts: Oversized shirt for Art classes

Lithuanian Mother Tongue class: a pencil box or case, 1 A4 format plastic folder, a blue fountain pen, 2 thin (12 pages) Lithuanian notebooks

Lithuanian Non-Native Language class: one A4 notebook, one document folder with rubber band closures

French, German, or Spanish Language class: pencil case, folder with rubber bands, a notebook

GRADE 3

- 2 boxes of tissues
- Antibacterial wet wipes
- 1 package of No.2 pencils with eraser
- 1 single plastic file folder with closure (snap or string) [A4 size]
- 1 pair of headphones with cord [3.5 mm auxiliary jack]
- 1 reusable plastic/metal (not glass) water bottle
- 1 pair of indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school)

PE: 1 pair of non-marking gym shoes, 1 drawstring (or similar) bag for carrying PE uniform (each student will need to purchase 1 PE kit at the beginning of the school year, distributed in PE class).

Visual Arts: Oversized shirt for Art classes

Lithuanian Mother Tongue class: a pencil case, A4 format plastic folder, a blue fountain pen, 3 thin 12 page lined notebooks (Lithuanian notebook for gr. 3 and 4)

Lithuanian Non-Native Language class: one A4 notebook, one document folder with rubber band closures

French, German, or Spanish Language class: pencil case, folder with rubber bands, a notebook

GRADE 4

- A planner, weekly layout
- 1 folder for homework
- 1 folder for unfinished work
- 12 or more sharpened pencils
- 1 package of erasers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 package of glue sticks
- 2 packages of post-it notes
- 1 package of highlighters
- 1 package of red pens
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 package of disinfectant wipes
- A4 notebooks
- 3 lined notebooks
- 1 grid notebook
- 1 reusable plastic/metal water bottle labeled with child's name
- Indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school, labeled with child's name)

PE: 1 pair of non-marking gym shoes, 1 drawstring (or similar) bag for carrying PE uniform (each student will need to purchase 1 PE kit at the beginning of the school year, distributed in PE class).

Visual Arts: Oversized shirt for Art classes

- 1 ceramic cup (occasional use, for washing and reusing at school)
- Scissors
- 1 pack glue sticks
- Headphones - 1 pair of headphones with standard 3.5 mm audio plug for Chromebooks
- Anti-bacterial wipes
- 1 pair of outside work gloves

PE: 1 pair of non-marking gym shoes, 1 drawstring (or similar) bag for carrying PE uniform (each student will need to purchase 1 PE kit at the beginning of the school year, distributed in PE class).
