## 2019-2020 School Supplies

Dear Parents,

Below you will find the list of supplies your child(ren) will need to bring on the first day of school in August. These are the items the school does not provide.

**NB! These items may need to be replaced/refilled and turned in to the classroom teacher after Winter break.** All supplies and clothing should be clearly marked with the **student's name**.

### Pre-Kindergarten

- Indoor shoes with hard soles
- Non-marking sport shoes ( Velcro preferred) & sports clothes for Physical Education
- A complete set of extra clothes (underwear, socks, shirt, pants, and sweatshirt)
- 1 plastic water cup
- A backpack
- A snack box
- 1 tea spoon
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 2 packages of baby wet wipes
- An oversized shirt for art with long sleeves
- For children who attend full day program: a pillow, an elastic bed sheet (130cmx60cm), and a blanket

### Kinder - Grade 2

- 2 packages of baby wipes (for Kinder)
  - A normal sized backpack
  - 3 boxes of tissues
  - 1 reusable water bottle
  - Indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school)
  - Tennis shoes (non-marking soles) & sports clothes (sweatpants) for Physical Education
  - Oversized shirt for Art classes
  - Complete change of clothes to be left at school (shirt, pants, socks, and underwear)
  - **For students attending Lithuanian mother tongue classes as of Gr. 1** - a pencil box or case, 1 A4 format plastic folder, a blue fountain pen, 1 thin (12 pages) Lithuanian notebook (for gr. 2 only)
  - **For Lithuanian non-native language class students** as of gr. 1 - one A4 notebook
  - **For students attending French or German Language classes as of gr. 1:** 1 A 4 notebook, 1 documents folder with rubber band closures, markers: green, red, blue
- For grade 2 students only:**
- A pencil box or case to be left at school (grade 2)
  - Blue and black pens for writing (grade 2)

### Grades 3-4

- A pencil box or case to be left in class
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 reusable plastic/metal water bottle/cup
- Indoor shoes with hard soles (to be left at school)
- non-marking sport shoes & PE clothes for Physical Education
- Oversized shirt for Art classes
- **For students attending French or German Language classes:** 1 A 4 notebook, 1 documents folder with rubber band closures, markers: green, red, blue
- **For Lithuanian non-native language class students** - A4 notebook
- **For students attending Lithuanian mother tongue classes** - a pencil box or case, 1 A4 format plastic folder, a blue fountain pen, 1 thin 12 page lined notebook (Lithuanian notebook for gr. 3 and 4), 1 thick lined notebook (24-36 pages – it can look like a dairy), 1 A4 format notebook (60 pages)

### Grade 5

- Non-Marking PE shoes to be left at school
- A supply of pencils and pens, to be refilled throughout the year.
- Markers or colored pencils
- Four A 4 size notebooks: 2 MUST have lines (not grid), 2 may be lined or grid
- Earbuds or headphones to keep at school
- 1 document folder
- A box of tissues
- A water bottle or cup for school use
- **For students attending Lithuanian mother tongue classes** - 2 lined thick spiral bound notebooks (A 4) for Lithuanian mother tongue class, a blue fountain pen

#### For students attending French or German Language classes in Gr. 2-5

- 1 A4 notebook
- 1 document folder with rubber band closures
- Markers – green, red, blue

### Grades 6-12

#### General supplies needed for all classes

*Please buy enough to last the entire year.*

- Pens – blue, black and red ink
- Erasers
- Glue sticks
- USB memory stick
- Colored pencils
- Markers
- Scissors
- Ruler – cm and inches
- Compass and protractor
- Pencil case
- **Bring Your Own Device Policy for Gr. 6-12** – students are required to bring their own computer to school every day. The device has to be charged and ready to use. We encourage the students to have laptop computer (Mac or PC platform or Chromebook), and although an iPad, a smart Tablet should suffice, attachable keyboard is required for these type of devices. Students should also bring their own personal headphones.

##### English Gr. 6-8

- 3 A4 lined notebooks
- 5 lined thin notebooks (A5 format)

##### English Gr. 9-12

- One A4 ring binder
- One A5 lined notebook (not for gr.11-12)
- One A4 lined notebook, spiral bound
- At least two highlighters of different colors

##### Science Gr. 6-8

- 1 monocromo notebook – grid ledger type, 20x29 cm
- 1 folder for documents
- headphones

##### Science Gr. 9-12

- 1 college ruled spiral bound notebook, A 4
- 1 quad ruled (graph paper) spiral bound notebook, A 4
- 1 clear or transparent ruler, 15 cm minimum
- 1 graphing calculator

##### Advisory Gr. 6-8

- A journal and writing utensil

### Math 6-12

- 1 monocromo notebooks – graph paper, ledger type, 20x29 cm
- 1 document folder with rubber band closures (*dokumentų aplankas*)
- Gr. 6-7 – simple calculators
- **Gr. 8 – 11 - Texas Instruments graphing calculator – TI-84 Plus CE**
- Gr. 9 - a ruler, a compass (*skriestuvus*), a protractor

### Social Studies Gr. 6-8

- 1 document folder
- 1 spiral bound 150 (or more) page lined A4 notebook

### Social Studies Gr. 9-12

- Two notebooks (can be A4) and pens

### IB Economics Gr. 11-12

- 2 ring or 3 ring hard cover binders
- Two A4 lined pages (no graph paper) notebooks

### Health Gr. 6-10

- 2 thin A5 bound notebooks (NOT spiral)
- 1 document folder with rubber band closures

### Computers Gr. 6-10

- USB memory stick – recommended

### Physical Education Gr. 6-12

- Gym shoes (non-marking)
- Shorts or sweatpants – preferably blue
- T-Shirt or sweatshirt – preferably blue or white

### Lithuanian Mother Tongue Gr. 6-12

- 2 lined thick spiral bound notebooks (A 4 size)
- 2 glue sticks
- Markers
- Pens (blue, black)

### Lithuanian Language and Culture (for non native) Gr. 6-12

- One A4 notebook

### French/German/ Russian Languages Gr. 6-12

- 1 A4 notebook
- 1 document folder with rubber band closures
- Markers – green, red, green
